



## **Notice of Race – 18HT Euro 2009 – Lake of Thun - 9. – 12. September 2009**

### **1. Location and Date**

Thun on the lake of Thun.

Wednesday 9. until Saturday 12. September 2009 in the area of the Camping Gwatt in Thun.

### **2. Promoter**

Swiss 18HT Association in collaboration with Segelclub Wendelsee SCWe.

### **3. Rules**

The rules apply as defined in the actual corresponding sailing rules of ISAF, including the additives of Swiss Sailing.

The international class regulations of the 18HT class with the national additives.

Federal law over the inland waterway craft travel and its local additions.

The notice of race and the sailing advise. In case of deviations the sailing advise applies.

In the case of doubt the german text applies.

#### **4. Admission**

Open to all helmsmen and crew which are members of an ISAF conform club within the respective country association. The Swiss Sailing regulation ,Startberechtigung an Regatten' applies.

The participants must be registered. The registration must have been accepted by the Swiss 18HT Association.

Restrictions: In case of less than 10 registrations the organization committee may decide whether the event will take place or not.

#### **5. Advertisement**

Swiss Sailing category C applies without restrictions.

Sponsor advertisement on the boats is planned (ISAF, regulation 20.3.1.d).

#### **6. Early Registration**

Registration has to be done with the respective web form ([http://www.18ht.ch/inscription\\_euro\\_int.html](http://www.18ht.ch/inscription_euro_int.html)). Regular registration fee is CHF 425.- (EUR 285.-) per boat (CHF 375.- (EUR 250.-). per boat for early registration until the 30.6.2009).

Early registered teams will receive a written invoice which has to be cleared until the 15.8.2009.

The registration may be annulated until the 9.9.2009 at 7 pm. In that case an organisational fee of CHF 200.- would be charged which in case of special conditions may be decreed by the organisational committee.

Every team has to present to the race committee a confirmation of an affiliation to a club or a valuable licence and an assurance certificate with a liability of CHF 1'5000'000.- minimum.

#### **7. Late Registration**

Late registration is possible until 9.9.2009 at 7 pm with a registration fee of CHF 425.- per boat.

#### **8. Mode**

The 18HT Euro 2007 will be sailed as triangle course with a discharging buoy.

Races will take place from Thursday 10.9.2009 until Saturday 12.9.2009.

There will be a maximum of 12 courses with a maximum of 3 strikes.

The mode will be published at the black board after registration is closed but latest Wednesday 9.9.2009 at 7 pm before the first skippers meeting.

The mode may be changed by the race committee if reasons exist.
